
### Talk on Menstrual Hygiene 28/02/22


### WEBINAR ON 'HIGHER STUDIES IN MATHEMATICS'


## Webinar on Internships & Placements


## WEBINAR ON 'INDIAN CONSTITUTION'


## WEBINAR ON 'WHERE CAN MATH TAKE ME?'


## 1. Webinar on Internships & Placements


## 2. WEBINAR ON 'INDIAN CONSTITUTION'

### **Report of the activities conducted**

#### **1. One day Workshop on PCB Fabrication, Soldering and Introduction to Electrical Wiring (house wiring) on 18<sup>th</sup> May, 2022**

A one-day offline workshop cum training program was conducted specifically for second semester BSc Electronics students on PCB fabrication, Soldering and introduction to electrical wiring (house wiring) on 18<sup>th</sup> May, 2022 to inculcate an interest in Electronics, and to remove the boredom sitting idly at home during vacation time can do. This will give an insight to hobby electronics, wherein students can be tempted to start assembling their own hobby circuits which if nurtured, they can develop to other bigger circuits.

Sri Deepu G P, Staff Co-ordinator, after first welcoming the First-Year students to their first off line workshop introduced the student volunteers – Sri Anantha Sankar (Electronics Association student representative), Sri Amjid S and Nibin S Binu were the Electronics student volunteers.

The resource person cum trainer was Sri Vipin S Nair, Technical Assistant, while Sri Nandu Krishnan, who completed his electronics degree and got selected through campus placement to WIPRO assisted in nurturing his juniors.
