Introduction

Survey Details:

Participants: The survey link was circulated among all Undergraduate (UG) and Postgraduate (PG) batches who completed their studies during the academic year 2022-23. A total of 45 students actively participated in the survey.

Survey Results:

The collected data was meticulously analyzed, and the findings were presented during the College Council and College Level Monitoring Committee (CLMC) Meetings held on 1.12.2023. The results provided valuable insights into various aspects of the educational experience at our institution. The analysis is added to the Appendix of this Report.

Summary of Key Findings:

The findings in the survey were almost good. Some areas which need attention were field visit, internship, interview skills and employability skill enhancement.

Discussion and Remedial Measures:

The discoveries were meticulously deliberated upon in comprehensive meetings that engaged both the College Council and the CLMC. A consensus was reached to initiate additional training sessions aimed at fostering employability and enhancing skills, spearheaded by the Career Guidance Cell of the College. The statistical data has been officially presented to the respective departments for in-depth discussions and subsequent actions, to be overseen by the DLMCs.






What subject area are you currently pursuing?



How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?





